Successful applicants will be expected to make a strong contribution to research, coordinate and teach undergraduate and graduate courses, supervise research students, and make a positive contribution to the reputation and administration of the school. This position will be based at the São Paulo Campus.

- Demonstrated academic knowledge in the discipline and consistent evidence of ability to deliver high-quality learning and teaching at undergraduate and graduate level
- Excellent communication skills, with an ability to relate to and engage with other staff and students from all backgrounds
- A completed Doctoral Degree is required
- Recognition (or potential of) as an authority in the discipline with a national and international reputation in research
- Excellent ability to teach in English
